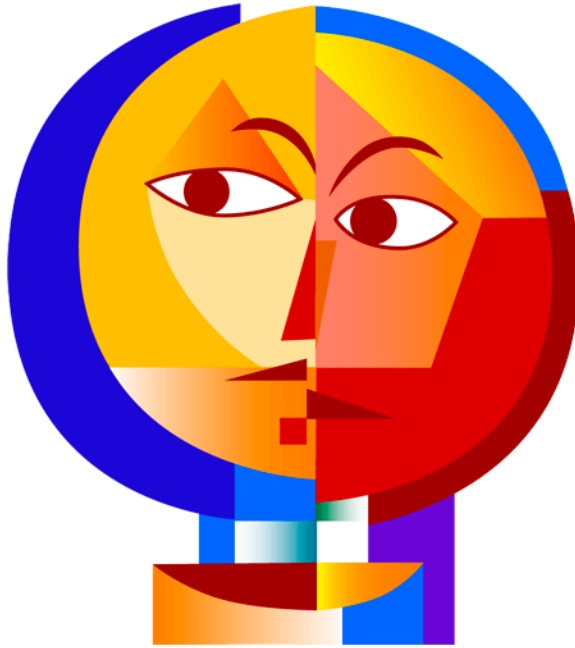


Facing Life with a Different Face

She brought the Let's Face It support network to the United States from England in 1987, and has ever since served as an advocate for persons with facial differences.
